

Students can <u>SELF STUDY</u> and take the Boost Camp Exam and pass with a 70% or better.

To Automatically be placed in English 7
Honors you must have A's **both semesters** of English 6

To Automatically be placed in Social Science 7 Honors you must have A's **both semesters** of Social Science 6

Honors Pre-requisites: A's both semesters of current English and/or Social Science classes.

Completion of an Academic Petition is <u>REQUIRED</u> if you do not meet the pre-requisites. Deadline to submit a petition: June 7th, 2024. Petitions are found here: https://forms.gle/pgwmJATprMA1pSWJ8

If you are interested in Honors classes but do not automatically qualify you can fill out an academic petition.

- 9. Beginning Strings (Yearlong commitment) No experience necessary.
- 10. Strings (Yearlong commitment) Minimum of 1 year experience. *Chamber Orchestra available for select ...

Leadership

Leadership Requires a separate application & a formal panel interview.

Due by March 28, 2024 NO LATE applications will be accepted.

Not all students who apply for Leadership are chosen

If you choose Leadership as a first choice elective be sure to choose a second elective.

If you are not automatically eligible for English or Social Science Honors you can complete a petition by June 7th.
